The Overall Vision

To provide students education/training through classwork & hands on experience in topics relevant to careers in manufacturing for those entering the workforce, technical training and college bound students.

The vision is to emphasize flexibility throughout the course of the program.

The program launched in January of 2026 with ongoing expansion over the program over the next two years.

The initial course - Mechanical & Electrical Technology Foundations (MET Foundations) launched in January 2026. An emphasis will be placed on exploring careers and opportunities in local industry through on-site learning. Two additional courses are planned in the 2026-27 school year.

Future coursework will be developed in conjunction with Northern PA Regional College, The Community Education Center, and the ECC Program Advisory Group. Throughout the program, students may earn industry recognized credentials: SACA and OSHA.

Instruction for the MET Foundations Course will be provided by the faculty of Northern PA Regional College.

A series of 6-8 courses with a senior year placement in industry. Opportunity to earn SACA Certifications and other relevant industry recognized credentials.

This program will provide ECC Graduates a head-start on careers in manufacturing, technical training or the study of engineering related careers.
